Why we chose to build a soap factory and teach soap making in Uganda

Mary Edgar came to our Soap Making Workshop a couple years ago to learn how to make soap. Mary is from Sparta, Ontario and lives in Uganda six months of the year and wanted to share with the women in Uganda how to make soap so they may have a means of earning a living to support their families. The soap making was a huge hit with the women in Uganda and everyone has enjoyed it very much as a community project.

Since this time, Jaydancin has taken the initiative to help this small community by building a soap factory and teaching them the fundamental tools in this craft to be sustainable. A key decision for us to do this project was because Mary has been in Uganda since 2006 and is familiar with the culture and lifestyle and will be a great assistance in helping us to accomplish this task. She can arrange for accommodation, food and safety for our teams and help us in the co-ordination of the building and setting up the soap factory. We will teach the women how to create and market their soaps using their own natural resources, to the tourists and local hotels
